

INSTRUCTIONS FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT: LET'S WORK TOGETHER FOR A PROPER DIFFERENTIATION

The aim of following instructions is to help you in the task of differentiating waste thus giving your contribution to protect environment and save money at the same time.

First of all a quick review of the basic tools at your disposal for correct waste management: the yellow sack, the transparent sack in mater-bi material, white containers for paper and the green ones for glass and cans.

B

- **Ballpoint pen** = transparent sack
- **Bottles and corks** = yellow sack
- **Glass Bottles without stoppers** = green containers
- **Blotting Paper** = transparent sack in mater-bi material
- **Soap and Detergents Bottles** = yellow sack
- **Books and Exercise-books** = white container (in apartment building) or tie them up if you don't live in apartment building but in detached house
- **Brochures** = white container (in apartment building) or tie them up if don't live in apartment building but in detached house
- **Bones** = transparent sack in mater-bi material
- **Baby's Napkins and Sanitary Towels** = transparent sack

C

- **Coffee grounds** = transparent sack in mater-bi material
- **Cast-off Clothes** = containers located on municipal land
- **Plastic Clothes-hanger** = transparent sack
- **Cassettes recorder and video cassettes** = transparent sack
- **Cables and electric materials (in small quantities)** = transparent sack
- **Cellophane (in small quantities)** = yellow sack
- **Cinder** = transparent sack in mater-bi material
- **PE, PVC, PET Container and packaging** = yellow sack
- **Cans and crushed ones** = green containers
- **Cigarettes-end** = transparent sack
- **Paper Carrier Bags** = white container (in apartment building) or tie them up if you are not in apartment building but in detached houses
- **Cleaned Rags and Clothes** = containers located on the municipal land
- **Cork** = transparent sack
- **Caps** = green containers

- **Vacuum Cleaner's Dust** = transparent sack

E

- **Egg-shells** = transparent sack in mater-bi material

F

- **Fish-bones and fish leftovers** = transparent sack in mater-bi material
- **Films and Cards** = transparent sack

- **Feathering** = transparent sack

- **Hairs** = transparent sack in mater-bi material

- **Dressed Leather** = transparent sack

- **Leather and imitation leather** = transparent sack

- **Litters**= transparent sack

- **Gone bad Nourishment** = transparent sack in mater-bi material

- **Nylon Stocking** = transparent sack

- **Newspapers and Magazines** = white container (in apartment building) or tie them up if you don't live in apartment building but in detached houses

- **Nut-shells** = transparent sack in mater-bi material

O

P

- **Iron or Aluminium Pots** = green containers

- **Peels, cores and fruits' stones** = transparent sack in mater-bi material

- **Pipe for irrigation system** = transparent sack

- **Wet, clean Paper and Cardboards** = white container (in apartment building) or tie them up if you don't live in apartment building but in detached houses

- **Dirty Paper and Cardboards** = transparent sack

- **Chemistry Paper of fax** = transparent sack

- **Packaging and Covering** (cellophane, film of nourishment), if cleaned and without residual of food = yellow sack

- **Plastic Plates, glasses and cutlery** = transparent sack

- **Dirty Plates, glasses, cutlery made of paper** = transparent sack

- **Recyclable Plastic** = yellow sack

- **Polystyrene (in small quantities)**= yellow sack

R

- **Razors**= yellow sack

S

- **Canvas Sacks** = transparent sack

- **Old but cleaned Shoes** = containers located on the municipal land

- **Synthetical Strip (Christmas strip)** = transparent sack

- **Straw and by-products of straw** = transparent sack

- **Seeds** = trasparent sack in mater-bi material
- **Stoppers** = trasparent sack

T

- **Tea** = trasparent sack in mater-bi material
- **Tetra-pack** = together with clean paper and cardboard
- **Tooth-paste** = trasparent sack
- **Toys** = trasparent sack
- **Tins** = trasparent sack
- **Tin caps** = green containers
- **Table napkins and paper-handkerchiefs (in small quantities)** = trasparent sack in mater-bi material

V

- **Vegetables and Leftovers** = trasparent sack in mater-bi material
- **Vegetables rubbish, flowers, plotted plants, greens, peels, pods...(in small quantities)** = trasparent sack in mater-bi material

W

- **Wads** = trasparent sack
- **Wicker** = trasparent sack

ONLY AT MUNICIPAL DUMP (Via Pace)

Things you can find in the following list, have to be taken to the municipal dump. Remember you can do so only if you're resident in Bollate (take your identity card with you).

- **Wood (furniture broke to pieces)**
- **Wood Clothes-hanger**
- **Metal (dish-washer, gas-oven...)**
- **Glass**
- **Polystyrene (in large quantities)**
- **Grass mowed**
- **Paper and cardboard (in large quantities)**
- **Cast-off clothes**
- **Refrigerating**
- **Little quantities of Rubbles**
- **All cumbersome articles (mattresses, armchairs...)**
- **Containers in which are kept toxic or inflammable materials (paint, spray, solvents...)**
- **Neon Lamps**
- **fax, printing and photocopier Cartridges**
- **Monitor screens**
- **Electronic components**
- **Vegetables and animals Oils (expired or resulted from frying)**
- **Oil (of a car, motor-bicycle...)**

- **Batteries (of a car, etc.)**
- **Expired Medicines**
- **Tyres without hubcaps**
- **Aereosol bombs**
- **Aluminium**
